Rosary – Tuesdays at 6:30 pm at St. Cecilia in the church.

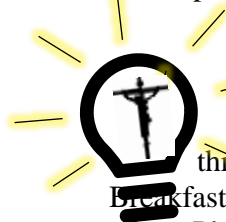
High School Youth Group – Fridays, 7:00pm at St. Cecilia Church.
